BYLAW NO. 5-2016

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF JANSEN TO AMEND BYLAW  
NO. 3-2014 KNOWN AS THE ZONING BYLAW (as amended)

The Council of the Village of Jansen in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts to amend Bylaw No. 3-2014 as follows:

1. Section 9.2.2 is amended by deleting:

“Front setbacks may be varied in infill areas but shall be consistent, within 1 m, with the setback of development on adjacent sites and with the general context of the block face.”; and

Replace this text with the following:

“Front setbacks may be varied in infill areas but shall be consistent, within 2 m, with the setback of development on adjacent sites and with the general context of the block face.”

2. Section 10.2.2 is amended by deleting:


“Front setbacks may be varied in infill areas but shall be consistent, within 1 m, with the setback of development on adjacent sites and with the general context of the block face.”; and


Replace this text with the following:

“Front setbacks may be varied in infill areas but shall be consistent, within 2 m, with the setback of development on adjacent sites and with the general context of the block face.”


3. That this bylaw shall come into force when adopted by Council.
