

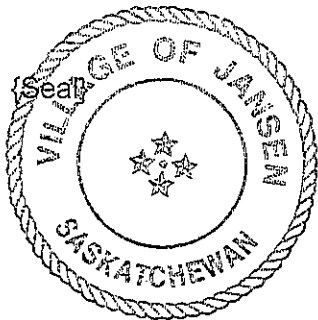

BYLAW No. 1/2015


A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH A BASE TAX FOR RESIDENTIAL IMPROVEMENTS/LAND, COMMERCIAL IMPROVEMENTS/LAND AND AGRICULTURAL IMPROVEMENTS/LAND.

The Council for the Village of Jansen in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:


- 1. This bylaw shall be known as the "Base Tax Bylaw".
- 2. A base tax of Four Hundred and Seventy Five (\$475.00) per assessment shall be levied on residential land and Two Hundred and Seventy-Five (\$275.00) per assessment shall be levied on residential improvements.
- 3. A base tax of Four Hundred and Seventy Five (\$475.00) per assessment shall be levied on agricultural land and Two Hundred and Seventy-Five (\$275.00) per assessment shall be levied on agricultural improvements.
- 4. A base tax of Four Hundred and Seventy Five (\$475.00) per assessment shall be levied on commercial land and Two Hundred and Seventy-Five (\$275.00) per assessment shall be levied on commercial improvements.
- 5. That Bylaw 7/2014 is hereby repealed.
