

# A BYLAW ESTABLISH PROPERTY TAX PENALTIES WITHIN THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF PRAIRIE ROSE No. 309

The council for the R.M. of Prairie Rose No. 309 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

**Due Date**

1. Property and other taxes imposed by the Rural Municipality of Prairie Rose No. 309 are deemed to be imposed on the first day of January in each year and shall be due on December 31<sup>st</sup>.

**Penalty on Arrears of Taxes**

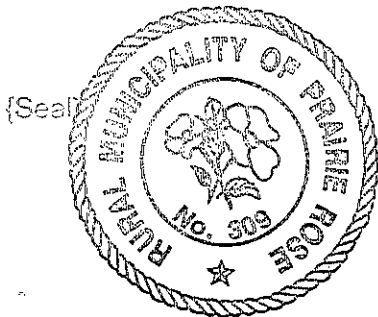
2. (a) Taxes which remain unpaid after the 31<sup>st</sup> of December of the year in which they are levied shall be subject to a penalty.  
(b) The method of calculating the penalty shall be a simple rate of 1% per month, added on the first day of each month applied to the total taxes, excluding any penalties previously added during the current year, that remain unpaid at the end of the month preceding the month in which the penalty is being applied.  
(c) The penalty charges are to be added to and shall form part of the tax roll.

**Repeal of Bylaw**

3. Bylaw #10/2012 is hereby repealed

**Coming into Force**

4. This bylaw shall come into force and effect on January 1, 2015
