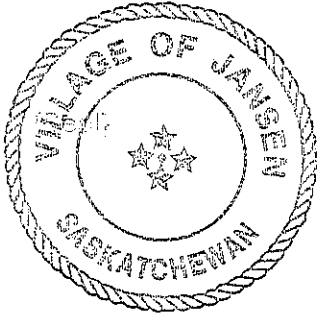


BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL FIRE PROTECTION


Council for the Village of Jansen in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. The Village of Jansen is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the Rural Municipality of Prairie Rose No. 309, the terms of which are attached hereto and marked Exhibit "A", for providing fire protection service.
 - a. In the Rural Municipality, the area referred to is specified in Exhibit "A".
2. The cost of providing fire protection services shall be paid by the Village and shall be assessed and levied within the said specified area in the municipality.
3. The Mayor and Administrator of the Village of Jansen are hereby authorized to sign and execute the agreement, the terms of which are set out in Exhibit "A".
4. That Bylaw No. 47/79 is hereby repealed.

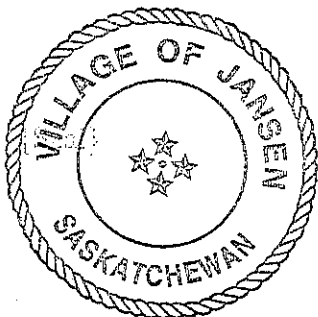
JANSEN & DISTRICT FIRE PROTECTION ASSOCIATION

This agreement made this 25th day of May, 2017 between:
The Village of Jansen and
The RM of Prairie Rose No. 309


- The purpose of this agreement is to provide for a fire fighting service to
 - i. All of the Village of Jansen
 - ii. All of the RM of Prairie Rose No. 309
2. At the written request of a participating municipality, the Central Committee may increase or decrease the designated protected area of that municipality. The Committee's decision shall be effective immediately and shall be conveyed in writing to all participating municipalities within seven (7) days of the Committee meeting at which the decision was made, and if the area is increased, the area shall be covered immediately.
3. A Central Committee shall administer this agreement, and any amendments to this agreement shall be made only with the unanimous consent of all parties.
 - i. The Central Committee shall be made up as follows:
Four members appointed by the Village of Jansen and one member from each of the four taxable participating divisions of the RM.
 - ii. Duties of the Central Committee:
 1. Elect a Chairman and a Vice Chairman from within the Central Committee
 2. Appoint a Secretary-Treasurer who need not be a committee member and determine the rate of pay for the Secretary-Treasurer. The Secretary-Treasurer and the Chairman or Vice Chairman shall be the signing officers for all cheques and documents of the Association.
 3. Appoint a Fire Chief who shall be responsible for recruitment and training fire fighters and for the direction of fire fighting and fire prevention throughout the designated protection area. Each municipality is to appoint the Fire Chief as their representative to the Fire Commissioner's Office in accordance with statutory requirements.
 4. Deal with all matters referred to the Central Committee by a participating municipality, and carry out all duties and responsibilities which arise in the operation of this Association.
 5. Prepare and submit a budget to each of the participating municipalities by January 31st each year.
 6. Regulate and set fees for fire fighting services.
 7. Hold meetings quarterly each year, or oftener at the call of the Chairman or any two committee members, and the Fire Chief and such members as he may designate shall be invited to each meeting.
 8. Minutes shall be kept of each meeting and a copy mailed to each of the participating municipalities within ten days of each meeting.
 9. Hold general meetings of all ratepayers of the participating area when deemed advisable by the Central Committee.
 10. Establish a trust fund into which all monies received from whatever source shall be deposited and from which all accounts shall be paid.
4. Contributions to the Association shall be made at the following rate:
The Village of Jansen shall contribute to pay 20% of the budgeted expense, and the RM of Prairie Rose shall contribute to pay 80% of the budgeted expense.
5. The level of contribution by the participating municipalities may be altered in any year, but only with the unanimous consent of every municipality.
 - i. Payments into the trust account by each municipality must be made before September 30th of each year of this agreement.
- The Committee may establish a reserve fund for capital purposes

8. The fiscal year of the Association shall be from January 1st to December 31st. The records of the Association shall be audited by a qualified accountant by March 31st of each year and a copy of this report and a statement shall be made available to every member of the Central Committee.
9. For the purpose of this agreement, the portion of the RM of Prairie Rose No. 309 that shall be taxed to provide for the said contribution shall be defined as follows:
 - Sections 4 to 9 inclusive, sections 16 to 36 inclusive in Township 32, Range 19.
 - Sections NW-3, Sections 4 to 9 inclusive, west half 10, sections 15 to 22 inclusive, sections 27 to 36 inclusive in Township 31, Range 20.
 - Sections 1 to 36 inclusive in Township 32, Range 20.
 - Sections 1 to 36 inclusive in Township 33, Range 20.
 - North half 31 in Township 32, Range 18.
 - Sections west ½ 4 to west ½ 9, west ½ 16 to all 21, sections 28 to west ½ 34 inclusive all in Township 33, Range 18.
 - Sections 1 to 36 inclusive in Township 33, Range 19.
 - All west of the second meridian and located in the Rural Municipality of Prairie Rose No. 309.
10. The Central Committee shall assume control of all fire fighting equipment owned by the Village of Jansen and the RM of Prairie Rose. An inventory shall be made of all equipment turned over to the Central Committee, and also of all equipment purchased by the Association.
11. The Central Committee shall arrange with the Village of Jansen and/or the RM of Prairie Rose for suitable storage facilities for the equipment. The association shall pay all costs of utilities, insurance and caretaking, as well as a fire alarm (notification) system. Upkeep of any and all premises shall remain the responsibilities of the owner(s) of the Fire Hall.
12. Any ratepayer may call for fire fighting service, and if informed by an authorized person that the Jansen & District Fire Department is unavailable, may call for assistance from another fire brigade, and the costs shall be borne by the Association. Assistance from other Fire Departments requested by the Fire Chief or his Deputy shall be borne by the Association.
13. If for any reason it becomes necessary to dissolve this agreement, the assets available after paying all liabilities, shall be paid to the respective contributing bodies in proportion to the equipment and assets contributed at the time this agreement was signed and in the proportion of annual contribution made by each of the member municipalities.
14. The member municipalities agree to perform and do all acts necessary in order to ratify and confirm this agreement and in particular the parties agree to pass a complimentary bylaw authorizing the execution and performance of this agreement.

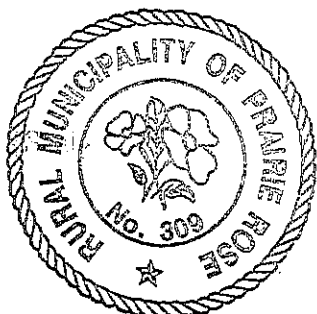
