SCHEDULE "B" BYLAW NO. 6/2012

PENALTIES

In addition to any other penalties which they may be subject to, any person who violates any provision of this Bylaw shall be guilty of an offense and shall be liable on summary conviction to the following penalties:

- 1) Any owner found guilty of an infraction of Section 3 of the Bylaw shall be liable to a penalty of \$250 per occurrence and should a person who harbours a dangerous dog not remove the dog by a given date, an additional penalty of \$25 per day shall be applied to the original \$250 penalty.
- 2) Failure to obtain and keep in force a restricted dog license, a fine of \$250.
- 3) Failure to obtain and keep in force a non-restricted dog license, a fine of \$150.
- 4) Failure to maintain in force a policy of liability insurance as required pursuant to Section 16 a), a fine of \$250.
- 5) Failure to confine a restricted dog when on the owners premises in accordance with the Bylaw, a fine of \$250.
- 6) Failure to muzzle and secure a restricted dog when off the owners' premises, a fine of \$250.
- 7) Permitting a non-restricted dog to run at large, a fine of \$150, and if convicted more than once in a twelve month period, a fine of \$200 for each subsequent conviction.
- 8) Misrepresenting a breed of the dog when making an application for a license, a fine of \$50.
- 9) Where any person has committed or alleged to have committed a breach of the Sections of this Bylaw specified in subsection a) of Section 4 and subsections a) & b) of Section 7, upon being served with a Notice of Violation may voluntarily pay to the Administrator of the Village of Jansen a reduced penalty of \$25 within ten days of the issuance of the Notice of Violation and upon payments so provided that person shall not be liable to prosecution of that offence.
- 10) The Notice of Violation shall be in Form 1 attached to and forming part of this Bylaw.

Every person who commits an offense under this Bylaw where a specific penalty for that offense is not set out shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$50 or more than \$250 upon summary conviction.

Conviction of a person for a contravention of any provision of this Bylaw does not relieve that person from compliance with the Bylaw and the convicting Judge or Justice of the Peace shall in addition to any fine imposed, order the person to perform within a specified period, any act or work necessary for the proper compliance with the Bylaw or to remedy the contravention of the Bylaw.
