

BYLAW No. 1/2003

**A BYLAW TO ENFORCE THE USE OF COVERS ON TRUCKS
ETC. UNDER THE NOXIOUS WEED ACT.**

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Prairie Rose No.309 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:


- (1) Any grain, fodder, silage, field crop seeds, crushed grain or cleanings of any kind, while being moved within the municipality must be covered in a manner that will prevent the spread of noxious weeds during such movement.
- (2) (a) Boxes on any truck or other vehicle used to transport grain, field crop seeds, crushed grain or cleanings of any kind shall be covered with a securely fastened tarpaulin or similar covering when moving anywhere within the municipality.

(b) Any truck or other vehicle used to transport silage or unbaled straw or fodder must be covered with a full tarpaulin or have an adequately installed mesh or screen type containment to prevent the silage, fodder or straw from blowing off in transport.
- (3) A legible card containing the provisions of this bylaw may be conspicuously posted in all grain elevators, seed cleaning plants, pelleting plants, seed warehouses and intensive livestock operations within the municipality.
- (4) Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to a fine as provided for in the "Noxious Weed Act"
- (5) Bylaw No. 1/87 is hereby appealed.
- (6) This Bylaw shall come into force on the day of final passing thereof.
