

BYLAW No. 2/2007

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH PENALTIES FOR CONTRAVENTION OF BYLAWS

The council for the Rural Municipality of Prairie Rose in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw shall be known as and referred to as "The General Penalty Bylaw" of the municipality.
2. Section 3 shall apply only to an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality for which no other penalty is provided.
3. Every person who contravenes any provision of any bylaw of the municipality is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction:
 - a. in the case of an individual, to a fine not exceeding \$10,000 and, in the case of a continuing offence, to a further fine not exceeding \$2,500 for each day during which the offence continues; and
 - b. in the case of a corporation, to a fine not exceeding \$25,000 and, in the case of a continuing offence, to a further fine not exceeding \$2,500 for each day during which the offence continues.
4. Bylaw 2/78 is hereby repealed.




