BYLAW No. 2/2007

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH PENALTIES FOR CONTRAVENTION OF BYLAWS

The council for the Rural Municipality of Prairie Rose in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. This bylaw shall be known as and referred to as "The General Penalty Bylaw" of the municipality.
- 2. Section 3 shall apply only to an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality for which no other penalty is provided.
- 3. Every person who contravenes any provision of any bylaw of the municipality is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction:
 - a. in the case of an individual, to a fine not exceeding \$10,000 and, in the case of a continuing offence, to a further fine not exceeding \$2,500 for each day during which the offence continues; and
 - b. in the case of a corporation, to a fine not exceeding \$25,000 and, in the case of a continuing offence, to a further fine not exceeding \$2,500 for each day during which the offence continues.
- 4. Bylaw 2/78 is hereby repealed.
